This section offers ideas for activities based on your observations, helping you create engaging and effective learning experiences that align with your child's unique preferences and development stage.

- Identifying Interests: Recognizing what captivates your child's attention or excites them.
- Skill Development: Targeting activities that foster the growth of specific abilities or competencies within your child.
- Behavioral Cues: Observing and responding to patterns in your child's behavior that indicate their needs or areas for growth.



Situation: The child shows an interest in nature.

Activity Ideas:

- <u>Nature Walks:</u> Go on nature walks and collect leaves, rocks, or flowers so they can discover them at home.
- <u>Garden Projects:</u> Create a small garden or plant indoor herbs to teach them about plant growth.
- <u>Nature Journals:</u> Start a nature journal where the child can draw or write about their observations.

Situation: The child is developing problem-solving skills.

Activity Ideas:

- <u>Puzzle Games:</u> Provide a variety of puzzles, such as jigsaw puzzles.
- <u>Building Blocks:</u> Use building blocks or construction sets to encourage spatial reasoning and creativity.
- Simple Experiments: Conduct simple science experiments that require testing.



Situation: The child has difficulty with social interactions.

Activity Ideas:

- Role-Playing Games: Encourage role-playing games to practice social scenarios and communication skills.
- Group Activities: Arrange playdates or small group activities that encourage sharing and teamwork.
- Social Stories: Use social stories to teach about social norms and appropriate behaviors in various situations.
